DOG ATTACK INFORMATION

Reporting Dog Attacks

It is necessary to contact the Rangers directly to report the incident. The Rangers will need to obtain information about you and the dog attack that occurred. As each attack is unique in its circumstances Rangers need to assess each incident accordingly.

Before contacting the Rangers to report the incident it would be really beneficial if the following information can be ready for the Rangers:

- Your Full Name
- Your Address
- Your Contact details e.g home telephone; mobile number
- Date of the Dog Attack
- Time of the Dog Attack
- Location of the Dog Attack
- Witness/s name and contact details (where possible)
- Detailed summary of the incident

Section 33D (1) of the Dog Act 1976 states that, if a dog attacks or chases any person, or any animal owned by or in the charge of another person, whether or not any injury is caused, every person liable for the control of the dog commits an offence .
